

# Police Training Application

## Crash Investigation I June 14<sup>th</sup> to June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010 John H. Stamler Police Academy

This Course is the basic training that will teach officers the proper techniques for recognizing and properly recording damage that occurs when motor vehicles collide. It also covers gathering critical evidence that may be used to reconstruct a crash at a later date. Related topics include information from people, roads, and vehicles. This course is designed for new officers or officers assigned to a traffic bureau. There are some basic math formulas taught and officers enrolled should have basic algebra skills and will need a scientific calculator.

**Eligibility:** This course is open to full-time police department employees on active duty. Priority will be given to applicants from departments within the area served by the AAA New Jersey Automobile Club (Union, Morris and Essex Counties) and to those who are members of such counties fatal crash investigation teams. A select number of seats will be reserved for those applicants working outside named counties. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**

**Terms & Conditions:** It is understood that the cost of tuition and books for this specialized traffic investigation training is being paid for by grants issued through the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety and the AAA New Jersey Automobile Club Foundation for Safety & Education. It is understood the applicant, should he/she be selected to participate in this course, will enroll and complete the course and be given leave for such a purpose, that it will not be charged against his/her vacation time, and that his/her salary will continue while attending the course.

**Notification:** Applicants and their departments will be notified of acceptance via email within six weeks of the application deadline. **Acceptance notification MUST be presented on the first day of class.** Only accepted applicants will be allowed to attend this class. Any persons not on the official class roster will not be admitted. Departments wishing to make substitution must notify AAA no later than one week prior to class start date. Deferred applicants will be placed on a waiting list and notified if a space becomes available.
